JOLANDA JONES~Scandalous

“Jones did in fact provide the public with a card entitled, ‘Know Your Rights With The Police’ and this card contained ... her City issued telephone number. Insertion of the City telephone number was **unlawful** in that the dominant nature of the card was that of a private advertisement for her personal law practice.”

JOLANDA JONES~Disgraceful

“Documentary evidence of such **misuse** of [Jones’] City fax was received.”

“Evidence found ... and subsequently corroborated, shows that a member of [Jones’] staff, while on city time, notarized and faxed a pleading ... in furtherance of [Jones’] private law practice.”

“[Jones] on a regular basis over a period of time, has had a member of her staff drive her to and from ... Courthouse ... a **commingling of a private and public purpose cannot be tolerated.**”

“A former staffer of Councilwoman Jolanda Jones has filed a complaint with the city’s Office of the Inspector General, accusing her of employee misconduct in cutting his salary by more than 18 percent **after he cooperated with investigators.**” *Houston Chronicle*, October 11, 2011

“The evidence also shows that council staff members were instructed to refer calls regarding the card to [Jones’] law office number. ... the Panel concludes that **CM Jones used extremely poor judgment** in listing her council office telephone number on the card.”

“Council Members cannot be bound by an executive order ... [but Jones] instructed her staff not to meet with the OIG ... thereby causing staff not to cooperate ... therefore **resulting in the staff being in violation of the executive order.**” Office of the Inspector General findings memo, September 28, 2011

JOLANDA JONES~Divisive

“We expect City Council members to encourage persons to work with the police. Jolanda Jones goes completely against that and **encourages persons NOT to work with the police.**”

“You imply that I am not really ‘black’ because I do not share your biased point of view,” Caynon wrote. “I do not know where to begin in responding, except to say that you and the race-baiting opportunists criticizing HFD [Houston Fire Department] deserve one another. I am indeed interested in keeping my job, and the choice between standing with the men and women of the HPPFA [Houston Professional Fire Fighters Association] or standing with you is not a difficult one. Your insults are unwarranted, ignorant and damaging.”
